Autonomous forestry – see it in action!

In October, an autonomous forestry machine, for the first time, managed the full sequence on its own: from detecting certain logs to picking them up. The test was carried out in north of Sweden as part of the work of Arctic Off-Road Robotics Lab (AORO). AORO is a co-operation between Luleâ University of Technology, Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences and the Cluster of Forest Technology. Research and development for the future's autonomous forestry is an important part

of AORO's work, paving the way for a more sustainable forestry sector.
